Engineering & Development Director James Emery announced that the Georgia Department of Transportation invited Troup County to apply for funding in the amount of \$427,000 for road safety improvements. Mr. Emery stated that in order to qualify a detailed project list would need to be submitted by close of business on Friday. He gave the Board copies of the list his department put together which included 77 miles that need re-striping. The project will be managed completely by the Georgia

Department of Transportation and is expected to beginning next spring and includes two traffic light replacements.
